**Papers:** MCCC members are invited to submit research or extension cover crop papers, fact sheets, and reports on replicated cover crop trials.

**State/Province Updates**: Each state/province is asked to submit a written report on research, extension, policy/communication, or other activities involving cover crops in their area. This would preferably be a brief listing of activities and contact people for each main activity area, along with the main contact person (Executive Committee member) for that state/province. **Note**: state/province oral reports on Tuesday afternoon will be <u>limited to 20 minutes</u>. We suggest highlighting a few activities in a little more detail, rather than reciting the list of everything going on this time, but each team may use their 20 minutes as they wish.

**Presentations**: Invited speakers are requested to submit an "extended abstract" of about 2 pages; or a short (2-5pg) paper written specifically for this conference; or your powerpoint presentation with some commentary; or an Extension article already written that would summarize many of your main points.

**Deadline**: Please submit all Papers, State/Province Updates, and Presentations <u>by February 14<sup>th</sup></u> to Eileen Kladivko (<u>kladivko@purdue.edu</u>). We intend to copy submissions and place into folders for all participants. Anything submitted after the deadline will <u>not</u> be included in the printed materials (unless you bring copies with you) but <u>will</u> be included in the electronic proceedings found on the MCCC website: <u>www.mccc.msu.edu</u>.
